**Sign up deadline: September 2, 2022**

The Anneslie Greening Committee has partnered with Blue Water Baltimore since 2008 to plant trees in our community. We have planted 149 trees, but we are losing trees faster than they are being replaced. Please consider planting this fall

Yard trees: \$75 installed (planted, staked and mulched)

Street trees\*: \$150 installed. The first ten orders will receive a \$50 rebate from the Community Association to offset a sharp cost increase and in honor of Anneslie's 100<sup>th</sup> anniversary

\* Register Road is not eligible for street trees. Murdock, Dunkirk, Anneslie and Overbrook Road street trees must be Black gum, Hackberry, Swamp White Oak or Shumard Oak. Winwood street trees can be any canopy tree except American Elm, London Planetree/Sycamore or Tulip Poplar. Homeowner must install a 8 foot long x 18 inch deep root barrier to protect the sidewalk prior to planting. Tree costs includes the root barrier. This video shows how to install a root barrier:
